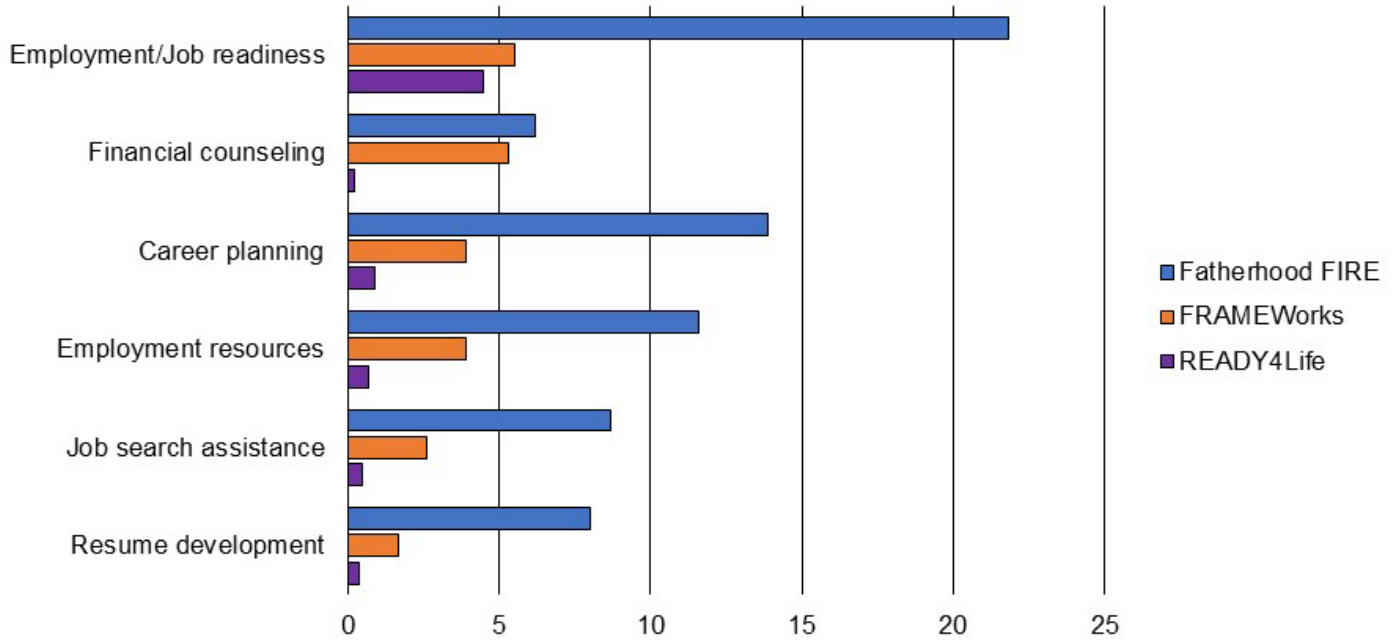


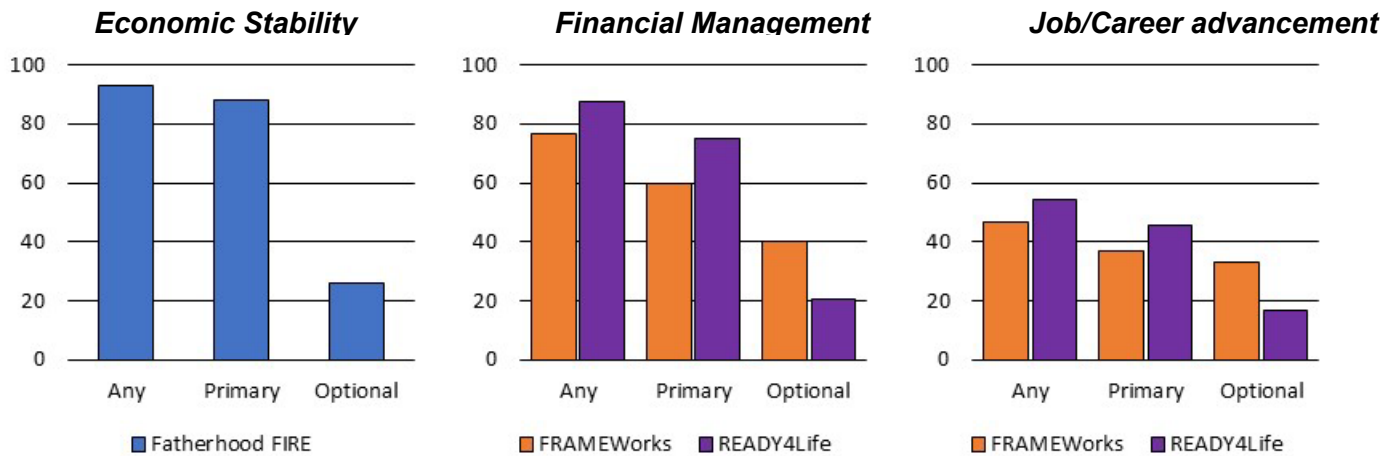

The snapshot reflects data entered into nFORM 2.0 from April 7, 2021, through July 31, 2023 for 112 grant recipients and 91,312 clients. This includes data for 58 Fatherhood FIRE grant recipients (27,774 clients), 30 FRAMEWorks grant recipients (33,800 clients), and 24 READY4Life grant recipients (29,738 clients).

Note: Each grant recipient determines the individual and workshop services to offer to clients, which must be approved by ACF. Workshop activity and element response options differ by grant type. The available response options are based on requirements in the 2020 cohort funding opportunity announcements (FOAs) as well as ACF's specifications for grantee data collection and reporting.
